### ABOUT THE CANADIAN STUDENT LEADERSHIP CONFERENCE (CSLC)

In 1983, the students and staff of Yorkton Regional High School in Yorkton, Saskatchewan were invited to host the annual provincial student leadership conference of 1985. The Honorable Grant Devine challenged the Yorkton group to turn the 1985 provincial conference into a national conference as one of Saskatchewan's contributions to the 1985 International Year of the Youth project.

The challenge was accepted and on September 18 -20, 1985, the first CSLC was held in Yorkton. Over 800 students and their advisors from across Canada and the United States (and even one delegate from Mexico) attended this conference, the theme of which was Youth of Today – Leaders of Tomorrow, and so, the Canadian Student Leadership Association was founded.

In recent years, we have also witnessed an increasing number of schools developing and offering leadership courses to high school students. These courses have helped individual participants become more knowledgeable and stronger, providing leadership in their respective schools and beyond. Both the national and provincial organizations have helped to equip individual student leaders with the necessary tools to enable them to be effective leaders.
